Members are enrolled in different programs based on their responses to the upfront Health Assessment and trends in their health data, ensuring that they **receive the most relevant information for their needs.**

Robust mental health support

Early identification and treatment of perinatal mood disorders is key, but often challenging in a clinical setting. Ovia assesses risk levels throughout a member's health journey, using regular touchpoints to gauge her mental state from the comfort of her own home, using her own phone. With this approach, **Ovia is able to increase identification of perinatal mood disorders by 60%** compared to traditional detection methods, enabling members to receive better mental health care.

Predictive analytics identify high-risk pregnancies and power referrals to Care Management

Ovia's solutions run on vast quantities of member data, enabling our predictive analytics to surface risks before they become costly complications. Ovia is able to identify high-risk pregnancies well in advance of claims identification by analyzing 76 high-risk triggers, preparing those members for Care Management engagement and referring them to your high-risk maternity program.
